- 3. During May 1583 A daughter, Susanna, (to be born).
- 4. During January 1585 Twins Hamnet and Judith (to be born).
- 5. Around 1590 Shakespeare (to write) his first plays, Henry VI Part I, II and III.
- 6. January 1593 An outbreak of Bubonic Plague in London (to close) theatres.
- 7. Around 1594 Shakespeare (to write) Romeo and Juliet.
- 8. Spring 1594 The theatres of London (to re-open).
- 9. Spring 1594 Shakespeare (to be) a founding member and shareholder of the Lord Chamberlain's Men.
- 10. August 11, 1596 Shakespeare's son, Hamnet, (to be) buried.
- 11. During 1599 The Chamberlain's Men (to build) a wooden theatre, The Globe.
- 12. During 1601 Shakespeare's father (to die).
- 13. March 24, 1603 Queen Elizabeth I (to die), and James VI of Scotland (to become) James I of England.
- 14. Around 1604 Shakespeare (to write) Othello.
- 15. November 1, 1604 The King's Men (to perform) in front of James I for the first time.
- 16. During 1607 Shakespeare's daughter, Susanna (to marry) John Hall, a physician.
- 17. During 1608 Shakespeare's mother (to die).
- 18. During 1609 154 of William Shakespeare's sonnets (to be) published.
- 19. During 1611 William Shakespeare (to leave) London and (to return) to Stratford.
- 20. During 1613 The Globe Theatre (to catch fire) and (to be) utterly destroyed.
- 21. During 1616 William's youngest daughter, Judith, (to marry) Thomas Quiney, a vintner.
- 22. April 23, 1616 William Shakespeare (to die) at Stratford-Upon-Avon of a fever.
- 23. April 25, 1616 William Shakespeare (to be) buried in Holy Trinity Church, Stratford-Upon-Avon.
- 24. November 8, 1623 A collection of Shakespeare's works, known as the First Folio, (to be) published by John Heminge and Henry Condell, members of the King's Men.

- 1. April 15, 1452 Leonardo da Vinci (to be born) in Anchiano (Vinci) to Ser Piero, a notary, and Caterina, a peasant girl.
- 2. During 1467 Leonardo (to move) to Florence as an apprentice to Andrea Verrocchio.
- 3. During 1469 Lorenzo and Giuliano de Medici (to become) new rulers of Florence.
- 4. During 1473 Leonardo (to draw) a landscape of the Feast of Santa Maria Delle Neve, his earliest known drawing.
- 5. During 1477 Leonardo (to take part) in painting the Annunciation to the Virgin.
- 6. During 1478 Leonardo (to write) in his notebooks that he (to begin) "Two Virgin Marys" and (to paint) the Portrait of Genevra de Benci.
- 7. During 1481 Leonardo (to receive) a commission for the Adoration of the Magi.
- 8. During 1482 Leonardo (to move) from Florence to Milan, on patronage by Ludovico Sforza. Leonardo (to write) in his journals regularly.
- 9. During 1483 Leonardo (to receive) a commission for the Virgin of the Rocks.
- 10. During 1489 Leonardo (to study) anatomy.
- 11. During 1490 Leonardo (to begin) a book on landscape and hydraulic works.
- 12. During 1495 Leonardo (to begin) the Last Supper.
- 13. During 1498 Leonardo (to decorate) the walls and ceiling of the Sala Delle Asse and (to make) his first attempts at a flying machine.
- 14. During 1499 The French army (to conquer) Milan and Leonardo (to leave).
- 15. During 1500 Leonardo (to go) to Manova and (to draw) the Portrait in Profile of Isabelle d'Este in Mantova. Lorenzo (to continue) to Florence and (to paint) the Virgin and Child with Saint Anne.
- 16. During 1502 Leonardo (to become) Cesare Borgia's military engineer. Lorenzo (to travel) and (to inspect) forts in Emilia Romagna.
- 17. During 1503 Leonardo (to begin) the Battle of Anghiari.
- 18. July 9, 1504 Ser Piero, Leonardo's dad, (to die).
- 19. During 1505 Leonardo (to make) a second attempt to build a flying machine. Leonardo (to complete) the Mona Lisa.
- 20. During 1506 Leonardo (to be) summoned to Milan by the French governor.
- 21. During 1507 Lorenzo (to be) appointed as painter and engineer for Louis XII. Leonardo (to paint) a second Virgin of the Rocks.
- 22. Leonardo (to move) to Rome and (to study) the properties of mirrors. Leonardo (to paint) the Turin self-portrait.
- 23. During 1515 Leonardo (to paint) John the Baptist. Leonardo (to construct) a mechanical lion for the coronation of the new French king, Francis I.
- 24. During 1516 Leonardo (to leave) Italy permanently and (to move) to France to serve in the court of Francis I.
- 25. May 1519 Leonardo (to die) in Cloux.

MICHELANGELO Buonarroti



- 1. March 6, 1475 Michelangelo Buonarroti (to be born) in Caprese.
- During 1489 Michelangelo (to begin) to study sculpture in the De Medici gardens. He (to sculpt) his first marble reliefs, The Madonna of the Stairs and Battle of the Centaurs.
- 3. During 1497 Michelangelo (to move) to Rome and (to sell) his first imporant work, Bacchus and another Cupid, now lost. Michelangelo (to make) his first trip to Carrara for marble.
- 4. From 1498 to 1499 Michelangelo (to sculpt) Pietá for the French cardinal, Jean de Billheres.
- During 1502 Michelangelo (to return) to a now republic Florence, and he (to receive) an order for a bronze David, finished by another artist and (to send) to France, now lost. He also (to receive) an order for a colossal marble statue of David.
- 6. During 1503 Michelangelo (to finish) his only easel painting, the Holy Family.
- 7. During 1504 Michelangelo's colossal David (to be set up) in front of the city hall.
- 8. During 1507 Michelangelo (to spend) more than a year on the bronze statue, and, less than four years later, it (to melt down) to make a cannon.
- During 1508 Pope Julius (to order) Michelangelo to fill the Sistine Chapel with frescoes. He (to protest), but the Pope (to insist), and Michelangelo (to finish) 1512.
- 10. From 1517 to 1520 Michelangelo (to complete) twenty-two statues for the facade of San Lorenzo.
- 11. From 1527 to 1528 Michelangelo (to become) Chief of Fortifications of Florence.
- 12. 1529 Michelangelo (to flee) Florence and (to be) declared a traitor.
- 13. 1534 Pope Paul III (to order) Michelangelo to paint the Last Judgment frescoes above the alter of the Sistine Chapel.
- 14. 1543 Michelangelo (to start) the Conversion of St. Paul fresco in the Pauline Chapel.
- 15. 1545 The Julius Tomb (to be set up) in San Pietro in Rome. Michelangelo (to begin) the Crucifixion of St. Peter.
- 16. 1546 Michelangelo (to begin) the Florentine Pieta' for his own tomb.
- 17. 1547 Pope Paul III (to appoint) Michelangelo official architecto of St. Peter's Basilica. He (to complete) a model in 1561.
- 18. 1555 Michelangelo (to get angry) of frustration, and he (to destroy) the Florentine Pieta'.
- 19. 1564 Michelangelo (to work) on Febrary 12th. Two days laster, Michelangelo (to come down with) a fever, and he (to die) on February 18th. Michelangelo's nephew (to take) his body to Florence, where it (to be) buried in Santa Croce.
